



INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY 2018/2020 II UPT ICM

The Erasmus International Credit Mobility (ICM) is part of ERASMUS + Program Action 1 - Higher Education - and aims to promote the mobility of people from higher education to and from partner countries.

The main objectives of this program are:

- Increase the attractiveness of higher education in Europe and support higher education institutions to compete in the world market for higher education;

- Support the priorities identified in the communications "Increasing the Impact of EU Development Policy: an Agenda for Change" (2011) and "European Higher Education in the World" (2013).

Support the internationalization, attractiveness and modernization of higher education institutions outside Europe with a view to promoting the development of partner countries;
Promote the development of foreign policy objectives and principles including ownership, social cohesion, equity, geographical balance and diversity. Particular focus is given to the least developed countries as well as to students with socio-economic difficulties and / or with special needs.

As part of the institutional application for Key Action 1 of the Erasmus + Program in 2018, Portucalense University obtained funding under the International Credit Mobility (ICM) for:

The ICM project with State University of New York in Potsdam predicts the following results: joint publication in indexed journal; 15h of debate about university learning methodologies that the research project involves; discussion forum on new collaborative and participative methodologies in teaching/research on the impacts of GCC (global climate change) on natural and patrimonial resources to be preserved and exploited by tourism; seminars on the environmental impacts of GCC on the economic development of the territory, on regional tourism, on wine production; III International Forum on Tourism and Heritage; II UPT ICM Meeting between partners of the ICM and of the Erasmus KA-103 program.

The ICM project with JINGGANGSHAN UNIVERSITY in China predicts the following results: joint publication in indexed journal; international forum in China; 15h of debate about university learning methodologies that the research project involves; two exhibitions, having as theme the Portugal /China relationship, in two partner museums of UPT; two language workshops (one at UPT and another at JINGGANGSHAN University); a workshop on Portuguese culture at JINGGANGSHAN University; a Chinese culture workshop at UPT; III International Forum on Tourism and Heritage; II UPT ICM Meeting between partners of the ICM and of the Erasmus KA-103 program.
